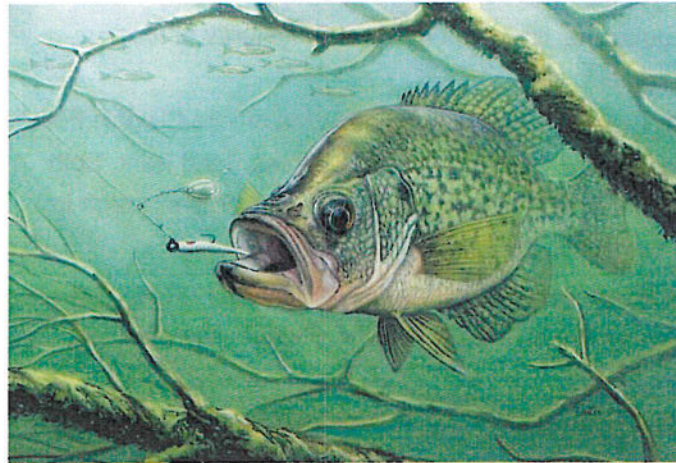

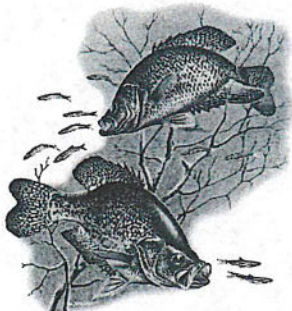

Rules

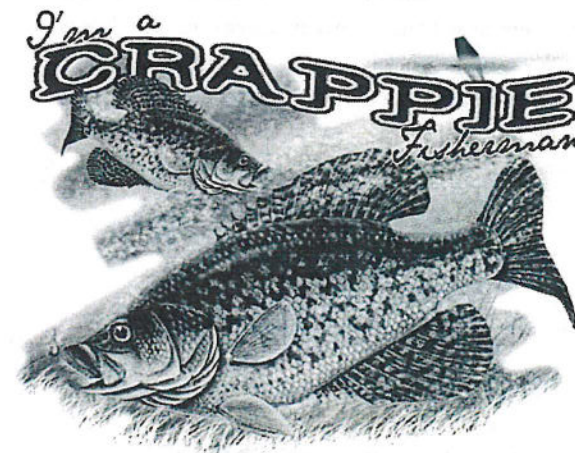
- 1. TEAM TOURNAMENT ONLY, must have a partner.** No fishing after 6pm the day before the tournament.
- 2. One boat per team only.**
Team members must stay together in their boat. No spectators allowed in boats.
- 3. In the case of extreme weather/water conditions,** Crappie For Cash reserves the right to postpone or cancel this tournament with the return of entry fees by mail.
- 4. Tournament waters shall be defined as areas of Toledo Bend Reservoir open to all participants of the event accessible by normal navigational means only.**
- 5. Teams may start fishing (line in water) anywhere on the lake at the designated time given at the mandatory meeting and may continue fishing until 12:00 noon.** Any fishing by a team member before designated starting time or after 12:00 noon on the day of the tournament will disqualify the team.
- 6. Teams may use rod and reel combos, hand held pole and reel combos or hand held poles.** Two (2) pole limit per person. One (1) hook or bait per pole applies.
- 7. Live or artificial bait may be used.**
- 8. Crappie must be hooked and landed with a rod or pole by team member(s).**



- 9. Teams must comply with all state fishing and boating regulations, licenses are the responsibility of team members.**
- 10. Crappie must be weighed at the official Crappie For Cash weigh-in site located at Cypress Bend Park.** Both team members must be present at the time of weigh-in to be eligible for prizes.
- 11. Angler(s) must be in line with fish by 1:00 pm.** No team will be allowed to join the weigh in line after 1:00 pm.
- 12. A team can not weigh-in more than 7 crappie.** Fish Must be alive. Once you have entered the weigh-in line, your fish will be checked for count and dead fish. You may then continue to the scales for your official weigh-in by the tournament director.
- 13. All crappie brought to the scales for weigh-in must have been caught during the tournament hours from tournament waters by the team bringing them to the scales.**
- 14. Big fish entries are included in the entry fee.** Only one Big Fish entry per team. Big Fish payout will be announced at the Mandatory Meeting.
- 15. A contestant who fails to pass a polygraph test or whose condition does not permit the administration of a test because of use of alcohol or drugs will be disqualified.**
- 16. One member of each team must be present at the mandatory meeting.** Only those present will qualify for the door prizes.



- 17. Any minor who participates must make arrangements to have a parent or guardian present at the time of weigh-in to sign a release form or have the entry form signed prior to the tournament to allow a polygraph examination if required by the tournament director.**
- 18. All protests must be made in writing to the tournament director within 30 minutes after the end of the official weigh-in.** All protests must cite the rule number(s) allegedly broken.
- 19. No alcoholic beverages are allowed during tournament hours or until all polygraphs have been completed.**
- 20. Instances of poor sportsmanlike conduct can be grounds for disqualification if circumstances require.**
- 21. Employees of Sabine River Authority are not allowed to compete in Crappie for Cash.**
- 22. Decisions by the directors will be final.**
